Ignite presentations are structured talks where each presenter has five minutes and a maximum of 20 slides. If selected, your presentation will be grouped with similar projects within a 50-minute time block. After all Ignite presentations have been shared, facilitated conversation will occur among session participants. This format ensures a fast-paced, engaging, and concise presentation. Be prepared to captivate the audience with the essence of your project!



### **Presentation Categories:**

We welcome Ignite-style presentations from current or previously funded AHW project partners aligned with:

#### **Health-Focused Research**

These session topics aim to delve into different aspects of how innovative research practices in basic science, clinical science and population science are being introduced and amplified in Wisconsin through MCW researchers. Sessions may also highlight topics such as innovative dissemination tools, new best practices in building and sustaining a strong trained investigator pipeline, or new capacities gained in WI to be a leader in research efforts.

#### **Health Workforce Education and Development**

These session topics aim to address key aspects of nurturing a diverse and multifaceted health workforce. Sessions may also highlight topics such as implementing effective recruitment, retention, and continuous learning strategies to optimize the current and future health workforce, or strategies to maximize purpose, resilience, and fulfillment among health workers.

#### **Public and Community Health Improvement**

These session topics aim to address the multifaceted nature of public and community health improvement. Sessions may also highlight topics such as deepening our understanding of the drivers of public health in Wisconsin, affecting measurable improvement in targeted public health markers, or innovation through system-level change strategies.

#### **Submission Guidelines:**

To be considered for an Ignite-style presentation, please submit an abstract by February 28, 2024, using the following outline. The abstract should include:

- Title of the presentation
- Name and brief overview of the AHW-funded project
- Intended impact on health in Wisconsin as a result of the project
- Results of the funded work
- Next steps or forward momentum

This abstract will be used as the session description in the event agenda and should form the basis of the Ignite-style presentation.

#### **Submission Process:**

Complete and submit the Call for Presentations application.

# **Selection Criteria:**

Submissions will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Clear alignment between the AHW-funded project and the event goal of maximizing the health of people, populations, and communities throughout Wisconsin
- Innovation and creativity in the use of the Ignite format



- Clarity and completeness of the abstract
- Agreement for at least one representative of the funded project to present in-person at the event on June 20, 2024
