Moreover, reviewers external to MCW may be paid for their service and Continuing Medical Education (CME) credits may be available for physician and faculty reviewers!

Who should apply to be a reviewer?

AHW is looking for reviewers with expertise in at least one of the following areas:

- Public and community health
- Health policy
- Health systems
- Clinical research
- Health workforce education and development
- Biomedical sciences, including basic science, clinical science, and population science research
- Statistics in biomedical, clinical, and population health research

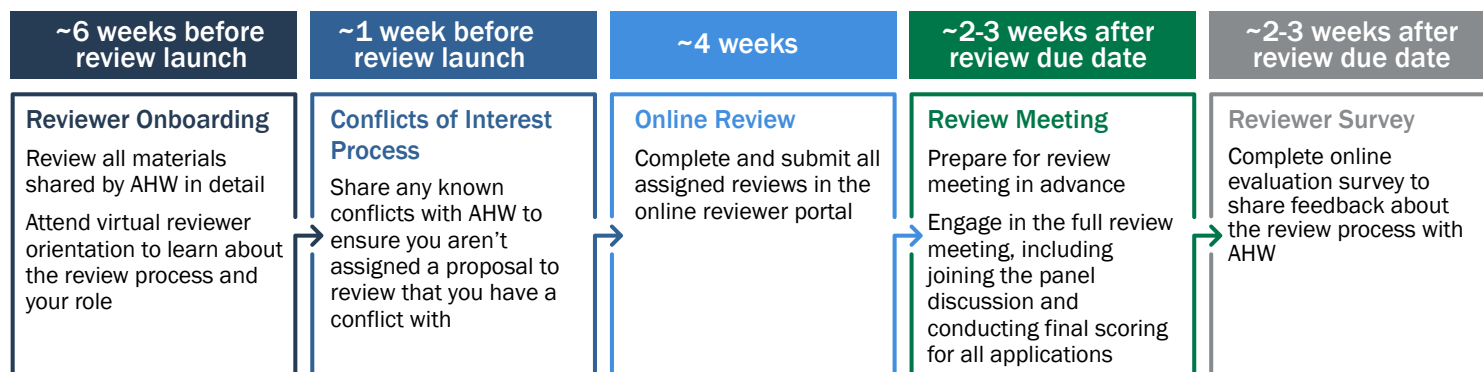


Reviewers should have a demonstrated knowledge of and commitment to addressing Wisconsin's health priorities. Prior experience with grant-writing and/or reviewing is helpful, but not required. Reviewers must be dedicated to impartiality in their reviews and be able to effectively communicate written comments of a proposal's strengths/weaknesses using provided review criteria.

What are the expectations of a merit reviewer?

AHW review processes often require a commitment from reviewers of approximately 4-5 months, and we ask that reviewers communicate early and often with AHW throughout the process regarding questions or conflicts that arise that may impact their continued engagement in the review process.

Here's a general timeline of a typical AHW review process. Not all responsibilities may be included in a particular review, and timelines are subject to change depending upon the particular review process.
